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MARÍA JOSÉ BRO VALERO

María José Bro Valero (Madrid) constructs her painting as a territory in constant dialogue between form and sensation. Her work moves between figuration and abstraction, exploring the landscape as a space of memory and emotion. The horizon line, the loose brushstroke, and the visible matter of the paint become vectors of resonance: each gesture traces a balance between the tangible and the intangible, between the present and the evoked.

Bro Valero's work invites the viewer to inhabit the pictorial surface, to perceive the tension between precision and the dissolution of form.



Her command of color, texture, and light transforms the medium into a sensory language that oscillates between serenity and movement, revealing the capacity of painting to be both record and experience simultaneously.

Beyond creation, Bro Valero extends her practice to teaching and outreach, consolidating an approach in which the transmission and sharing of artistic knowledge become an inseparable part of her work. In her art, painting not only represents but vibrates: a space where time, memory, and perception converge, offering a perspective that is at once intimate and expansive.

FLÓREZ DE URÍA

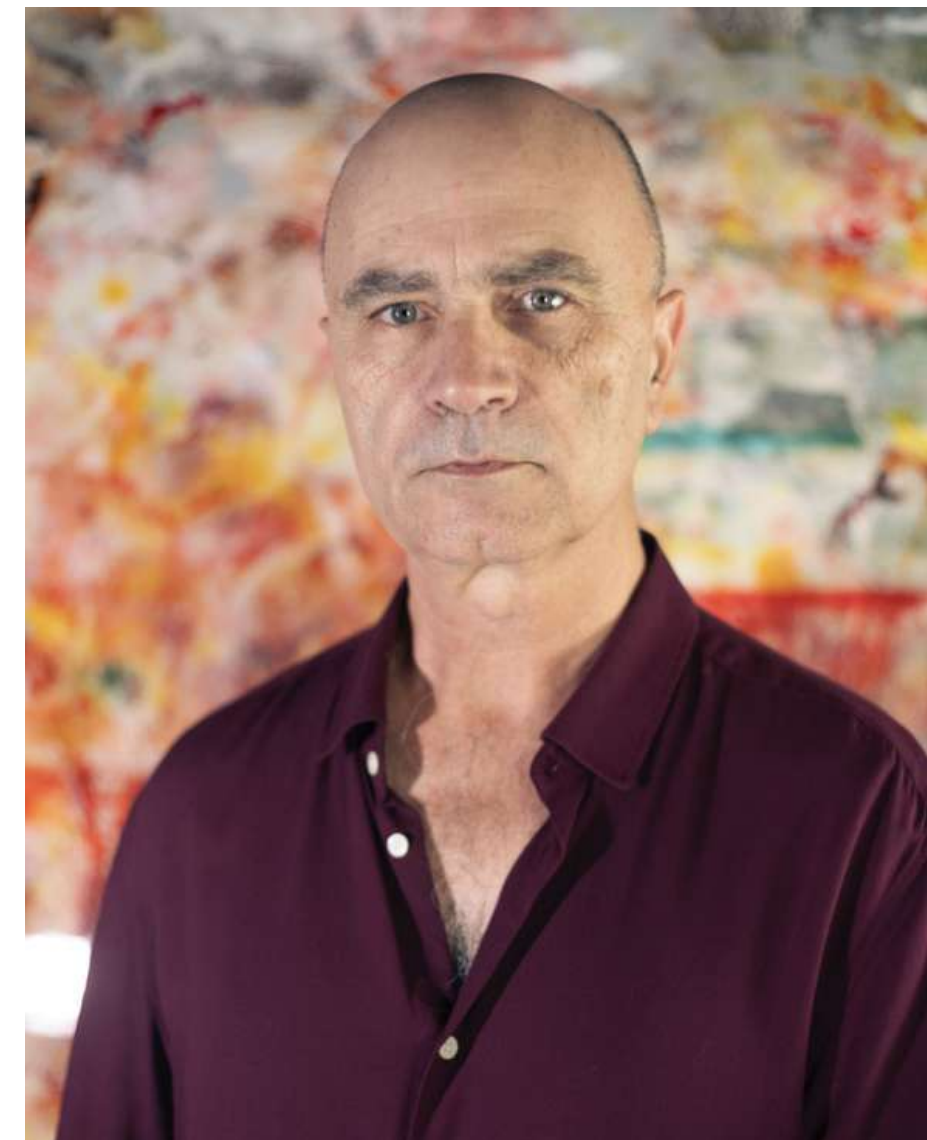
Contemplating the work of Flórez de Uría (Madrid, 1960) invites us on an emotional journey where there are no literal images, but there are profound and shifting sensations.

His painting integrates light, shadow, color, texture, and movement, conveying the strength of the creative process between artist and viewer.

Flórez de Uría is a tireless, innovative creator and a leading figure in contemporary abstract expressionism.

Everyday life and the perception of reality permeate his work, pouring in dreams, emotions, and reflections on technological and material changes. He uses diverse media and supports, combining materials that overlap and dissolve, creating an expressive whole in constant transformation.

His series—Heterogéneo, Materiales, Polímeros, Materia, among others—explore color, darkness, linearity, and multilayering, always surprising the viewer. He has achieved a personal style that reflects maturity, professionalism, and the ability to fully express his feelings, generating a magical dialogue with those who observe.

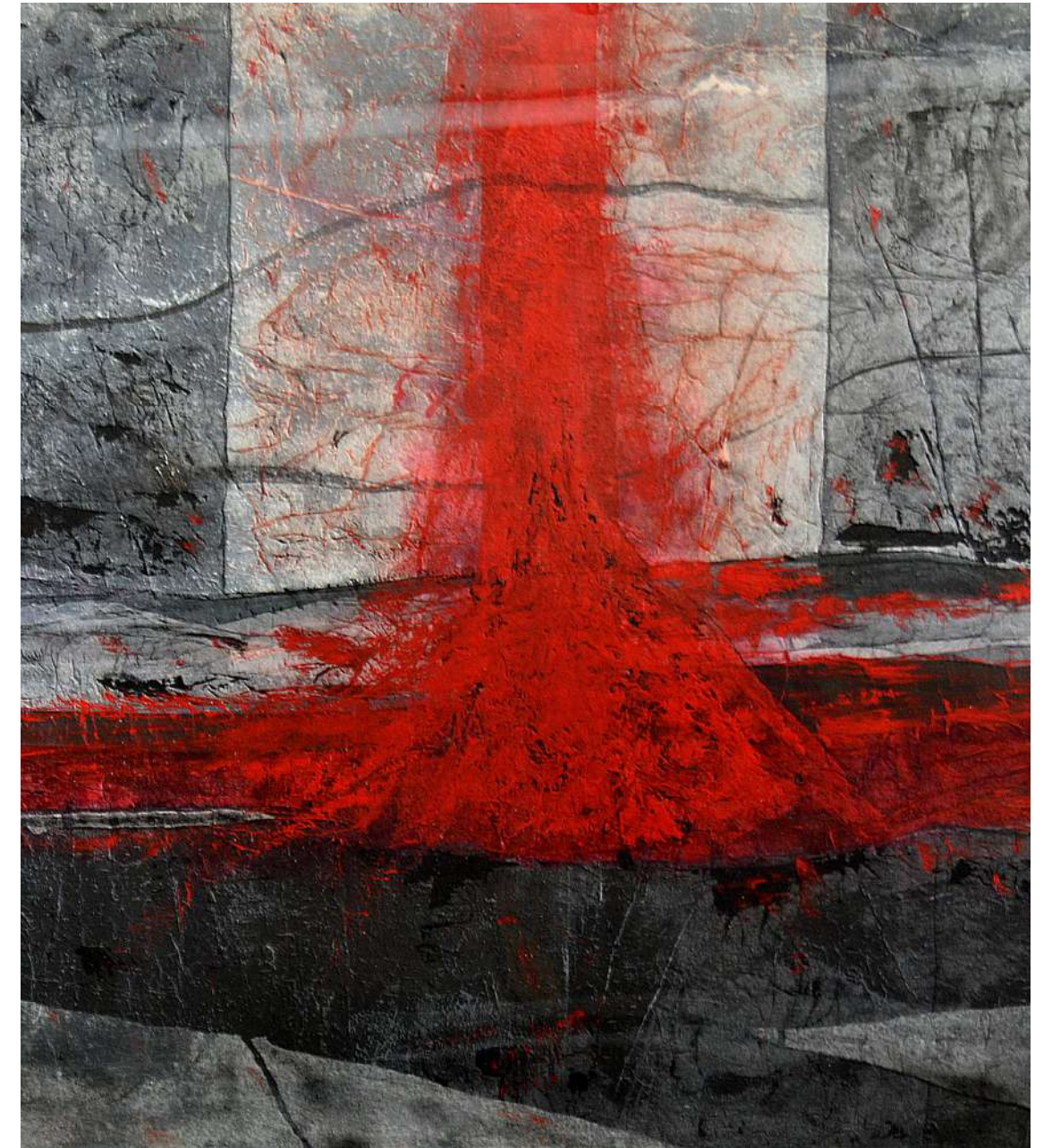

DAVID BARTLETT

David Bartlett creates works that function like mandalas, inviting contemplation and attunement to the invisible flow of life. His practice, developed over more than fifty years, traces an emotional, sensory, and intellectual journey that reflects the pursuit of connection and harmony that defines Resonance. Inspired by Humanistic Buddhism and guided by compassion, Bartlett transforms the viewer's perception into part of the energy circulating through the work.

His painting explores associative abstraction, geometry, symmetry, color harmony, and expressive gesture, generating a field of resonance that invites listening, feeling, and responding. Each stroke and each title act as a channel of exchange between the work and the observer, revealing that true resonance arises in the subtle dialogue between matter, emotion, and consciousness.

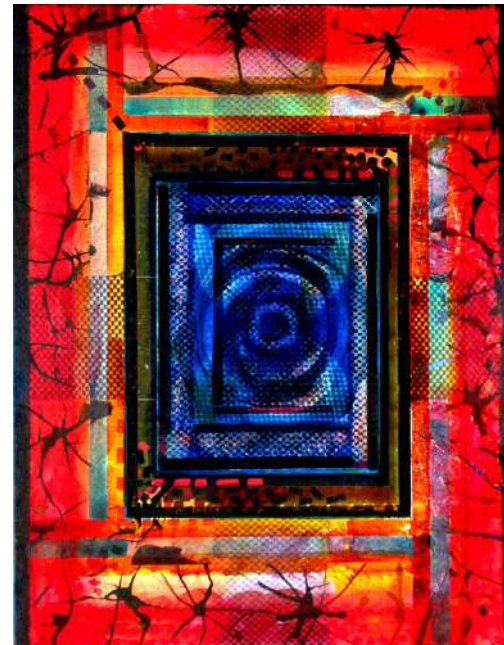

ANDRIANA KEDARITI

Andriana Yemetta Kedariti (Cyprus) moves gracefully between painting, ceramics, and memory, transforming clay and pigment into witnesses of intimate and collective stories.

Inspired by ancient Cypriot pottery and personal migration—a childhood marked by displacement—her work proposes that the past should not be relegated but incorporated, reinterpreted, and felt.

Each piece is a celebration of the handmade, a bridge between yesterday and today, where traditional motifs appear as guardians of continuity and identity. She works with care, listening to the material as much as to her own experiences, offering the viewer not just an object but a space for reflection and connection.

In Kedariti's work resides the conviction that art can sustain memory, honor lived experience, and offer new beginnings. Her art-life practice invites us to pause, contemplate, and recognize that each stroke, each curve, carries a story that deserves to be heard.

The practice of Martin Vild and Šárka Vildová, under the Vild Art label, proposes a space of living abstraction: pictorial genres that combine technique, texture, scale, and detail to activate sensations and inversions.

Their work—based on acrylic painting, technical experimentation, and free expression—aims not only to attract the eye but to prolong the experience and generate an emotional dialogue with the viewer.

In this series, vitality, inversion, and artistic commitment converge: the object-work circulates as a medium of conscious attention, inviting the viewer to discover new corners with each encounter.

In this way, Vild Art suggests that abstract painting is both a form of beauty and an opportunity for participation, belonging, and reflection.
